

How to release the Unsigned Driver in Windows 8 / 8.1 and 10.

Windows 8 / 8.1 and 10 don't let you install unsigned drivers. The following message appears during installation unsigned drivers.



In order to install the MB2 driver, follow the steps below to execute *Disable Driver Signature Enforcement* mode.

1. Go to "Control Panel Home" \rightarrow "System and Security" \rightarrow "Security and Maintenance" or "Action Center"

2. Click "Change Windows SmartScreen settings" and choose the bottom "Don't do anything (turn off Windows SmartScreen)" and click "OK" button

3. Select "Restart" from the power options menu and hold down the "SHIFT" key while you click Restart. Otherwise go to "Settings" \rightarrow "Update & security" \rightarrow "Recovery" \rightarrow "Restart now" in the Advanced startup.

Once your computer has rebooted you will be able to choose the Troubleshoot option.

Go to "Troubleshoot" \rightarrow "Advanced options" \rightarrow "Startup Settings" \rightarrow "Restart"







- 4. During restarting, the following "Startup Settings" menu comes up and select
 - "7) Disable driver signature enforcement" by pushing keyboard 7.



The MB2 USB driver now can install, refer to "Quick Setup Guide".

After finish the installation of MB2 USB driver, we recommend you back to the default setting. Back to "Control Panel" \rightarrow "System and Security" \rightarrow "System and Maintenance" or "Action Center" \rightarrow "Change Windows SmartScreen settings" and choose "Get administrator approval......" and click "OK" button.
